Alde Heating Mat enhances warmth and comfort in the motorhome.


The heating mat is made of materials from the commercial vehicle industry:

- Available in different format and models to fit your motorhome.



Alde heating mat is available in the following Left-Hand Drive chassi models:






This is how it works
